## Workshop proceedings and one conference proceeding

Four workshops were held in September 2013, August 2014, September 2015 and August 2016. The final conference was held in Brussels on 29 September 2016.

### Workshop 2013

EU-PLF co-organised the EC-PLF conference in Leuven (Belgium) on 10-12 September 2013. The programme is provided in the assigned document “EC-PLF2013\_Programme.pdf”. The proceedings of the conference were published as a book and a CD-ROM entitled “Precision Livestock Farming ‘13”, Edited by D. Berckmans and J. Vandermeulen, 970 pages.

### Workshops 2014

EU-PLF co-organised a full day symposium on Precision Livestock Farming on Monday 25th August 2014, within the frame of the 65th Annual Meeting of the EAAP, held in Copenhagen, Denmark (see assigned document “Copenhagen\_2014\_Abstracts.pdf”). The session was divided into a full session in the morning (session 5) and three parallel sessions in the afternoon (sessions 10, 11 and 12) as described in page 16. The programme of session 5 is described in pages 24-25 and the abstracts are provided in pages 97-108. The programmes for sessions 10-12 are described in pages 30-32 and the abstracts are provided in pages 148-160. The proceedings of the symposium have been published by Wageningen Academic Publishers in 2015 as a book “Precision livestock farming applications: Making sense of sensors to support farm management”, Editor Ilan Halachmi, 328 pages; eISBN: 978-90-8686-815-5 | ISBN: 978-90-8686-268-9; DOI: <http://dx.doi.org/10.3920/978-90-8686-815-5>. ### Workshop 2015

### Workshop 2016

EU-PLF co-organised a full day symposium on Precision Livestock Farming on Thursday 1st September 2016 within the frame of the 67th Annual Meeting of the EAAP, held in Belfast, UK (see assigned document “Belfast\_2016\_Abstracts.pdf”). The session was divided into a session in

## Final conference 2016

The conference was held in the Residence Palace, Brussels, on 29th September 2016. The programme is described in the assigned document “EU-PLF\_FinalConference\_programme.pdf”. A total of 132 participants from 17 countries participated in the conference. The proceedings are available on the public website.
